What to Expect:

- One giant picnic blanket, approximately 260 square metres in size.
- Each picnic spot is approximately 2.5m x 2.1m.
- There will be giant lawn games, board games, jigsaw puzzles, craft and cards, music, live entertainment and silent disco.
- This event is open to all ages and abilities.
- Located on a grassed area within Christsen Park, 1A
 Esplanade, Bargara. There is a step-free pathway to
 the grassed area from the car park. The grassed area
 is uneven in some parts and may be difficult for
 people with vision or mobility loss to safely traverse.

Why It is Special:

- Inclusive for all: A family-friendly event designed for all ages and abilities.
- Interactive fun: Sit on the GIANT picnic blanket, play a board game or giant lawn game. Listen to the live entertainment or use our silent disco headphones.

- Engaging experience: Enjoy the event at your own pace, join in as much or as little as you choose.
- A community celebration: A chance to connect, play and create memories together.

Christsen Park Accessibility

Park Accessibility

Some areas of the park pool water in rain events. We suggest contacting Bundaberg Regional Council Parks and Gardens team to check accessibility of areas prior to visiting. Phone 1300 883 699.

From the car park, there are step-free concrete and paved pathways to the grassed area where Bundy's Biggest Picnic will be located.

The paths through and around the areas of the park are a mixture of pavers and concrete.

Playground

This is a large, shady, playground with a range of equipment that is not easily accessible to children who use wheelchairs or other mobility devices. The equipment is surrounded by sand or Tanbark. There is a

large picnic/barbecue shelter in the playground which has level access. There is also an accessible drinking fountain with a low height spout for dogs.

A locally owned and operated service, to get you where you need to go. Unable to accommodate wheelchairs, there is room for prams, walkers, crutches, and canes.

Accessible Parking

There are accessible parking spaces in the car park at Christsen Park with step free access to the park and playground.

Accessible Drop-off Zone

There is a drop off point at Christsen Park with step free access to the park and playground.

Accessible Public Toilet Facilities

The accessible toilet facilities are located inside the park.

There is two unisex accessible toilets. The accessible

toilets cubicles include:

- Approximately 1000mm of clear space for transfers
- Grab rails
- A roll-under sink
- A mixer tap with a lever handle

Assistance Animals

Assistance animals are welcome at the Christsen Park, including Bundy's Biggest Picnic event. There are grassy areas available throughout the park for assistance animal toileting. Please note that handlers are responsible for cleaning up after their animals. Free drinking water is available at taps and fountains in the park and along the paths.

Sensory-friendly Spaces

This event doesn't have specific sensory-friendly areas. We can offer maps with clear information about loud or busy areas, helping attendees plan their experience.

Please let us know before you attend if you need support or have special requests, and we will do our best to assist you.

Signage

To help you navigate the event, signage at entry, exit and platter collection point with large, easy-to-read text will be placed at the event.
